Topic/Concept/Skill: Insects
Teacher Materials: 22 Let's Take a Closer Look at Insects worksheets, 2 bags of marshmallows, bag of m\&m's, bag of pretzel sticks, jar of peanut butter, photos of insects: ladybug, ant, fly, bee, butterfly, jar of insects

Student Materials: pencil, worksheet, 3 marshmallows, 2 m\&m's, 8 pretzel sticks
Anticipatory Set (Introductory Approach): I will show the video Icky Insects by Silly Bus at the beginning of the lesson.

Instructional Procedures (Whole Group):

1. After the video I will review the main parts of the insect: head, thorax, abdomen and they have 6 legs, 2 antennas, and an exoskeleton
2. After the review I will divide the students up into groups and they will look at pictures of a certain insect. The students will fill out a paper will looking at the pictures.
3. When the students are done, they will present their insect to the rest of the class.
4. I will have the students write down a new fact about the other groups' insect.
5. Next, I will pass out materials to make food insects.
6. When the students are done making their insects we will review the body parts of the insect before the students put their insect creations in their book bag.

Provisions for Individual and/or Group Differences:
Closure: When the students are done making their insects we will review the body parts of the insect before the students put their insect creations in their book bag.

Evaluation of Learning: I will collect the students' paper that they filled out and mark it with a star for completion.
